# Annual General Meeting Report of Hong Kong Society of Theoretical and Applied Mechanics March 15, 2014

#### 1 Main Activities (Since March 2013)

#### 1.1 Distinguished Lectures

There were four Distinguished Lectures before the HKSTAM conference, and another four Distinguished Lectures are organized in the HKSTAM annual conference. Therefore, a total of **8 Distinguished Lectures** were organized in this year.

The four Distinguished Lectures organized before the HKSTAM conference are:

- 1. Distinguished Lecture 1 by Prof. Xiao Qiao HE (CityU) on 1 June 2013
- 2. Distinguished Lecture 2 by Prof. Robert O. Ritchie (Lawrence Berkeley National Laboratory) on 19 July 2013
- 3. Distinguished Lecture 3 by Prof. Wieslaw Ostachowicz (Polish Academy of Sciences, Institute of Fluid Flow Machinery, Poland) on 13 December 2013
- 4. Distinguished Lecture 4 by Prof. Wing Kam Liu (Northwestern University) on 16 December 2013

A total of **over 120 participants** attended the lectures. Please find detail report of each lecture in the following sub-sections.

#### 1.1.1 Distinguished Lecture 1: Nano-Mechanics of Carbon Nanotubes (Prof. Xiao Qiao HE)

Prof. Xiao Qiao HE is from the Department of Civil and Architectural Engineering, City University of Hong Kong. The seminar started at 10:00am on 1 June 2013 (Saturday) in Room B6605. The seminar was chaired by Prof Paul LAM and there were **30 participants** (see Photo 1). The seminar was well organized and informative. There were a lot of discussions after the presentation. The seminar completed at 11:10am.

## 1.1.2 Distinguished Lecture 2: Probing the Structure and Properties of Engineering and Biological Materials at Multiple Length-Scales using Real-Time Imaging (Prof. Robert O. Ritchie)

Prof. Robert O. Ritchie is from the Lawrence Berkeley National Laboratory. The seminar started at 2:30pm on 19 July 2013 (Friday) in LT-9, CityU. The seminar was chaired by Dr. Paul Lam. 

#### 1.2 HKSTAM Annual Conference

In this year, the HKSTAM annual conference is organized in conjunction with "the 10th Shanghai—Hong Kong Forum on Mechanics and Its Application". The conference is held on **March 15, 2013 at City University of Hong Kong (CityU)**. HKSTAM organized this conference together with the Shanghai Society of Mechanics (SSM), and City University of Hong Kong. The one-day conference aims to provide a platform for all scientists, engineers, and mathematicians working on mechanics and related areas to share, communicate and exchange ideas, and to enhance co-operations within relevant parties.



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There are totally **44 abstracts** submitted to this conference including **4 Distinguished Lectures**. They are offered by **Prof. Andrew YT LEUNG** from Hong Kong Society of Theoretical and Applied Mechanics (HKSTAM), **Prof. Zheng ZHONG** from Shanghai Society of Mechanics (SSM), **Prof. Dong SUN** from City University of Hong Kong, and **Prof Li CHENG** from Hong Kong Polytechnic University (PolyU). The other 40 abstracts are given in 8 parallel sessions.

A total of **65 registered participants** in the conference including 15 EC members, 8 SSM participants, 4 invited speakers, 38 local participants. Due to the new policy in Shanghai, many participants from SSM cannot apply for financial support, and therefore, only 2 of them can join the conference.
