Call for Abstract – 1st Announcement

The 29th Annual Conference of HKSTAM 2026 in conjunction with the 21st Jiangsu–Hong Kong Forum on Mechanics and Its Applications will be held **17-20 April 2026** at The Hong Kong Polytechnic University (PolyU), Hong Kong SAR, China. This conference is co-organized by the Hong Kong Society of Theoretical and Applied Mechanics (HKSTAM) and the Jiangsu Society of Theoretical and Applied Mechanics (JSTAM). PolyU is proud to be the sponsor to this conference. The conference topics cover mechanics and its applications in all science and engineering disciplines.

The conference technical sessions are scheduled on 18 April 2026, which include invited keynote lectures and a series of parallel sessions. The due date for submitting one A4-page extended-abstract in MS word file is **28 February 2026**. The abstract must include the information title, authors, affiliations, and email address of the corresponding author and presenter. Please use the attached extended-abstract template in MS Word format in preparing the extended abstract for submission. All accepted abstracts will be included in the HKSTAM Conference Proceedings. Student presenters are eligible for competing the “**HKSTAM Annual Conference Best Student Presentation Award**”.
